

2nd AHQ Summer Workshop at Daytona Beach

Daytona Beach College/Embry Riddle Aeronautical University,

Thank you for your interest in the 2nd AHQ Summer Workshop at Daytona Beach. Below you will find information about the course and coming to Daytona Beach. If you are interested in attending, please complete the application and return it before 30 June 2008 to ensure your participation!

***Daily events** will include a warm-up each morning with a different AHQ member, group lessons, master classes, solo literature classes, horn ensembles and concerts. Concerts will take place in the Daytona Beach College (DBC) concert hall and at various locations throughout the area. Private lessons with AHQ members are available at the rate of \$100 per hour/\$60 per half hour.

***Faculty** for 2008 includes the American Horn Quartet: David Johnson, Charles Putnam, Kerry Turner and Geoffrey Winter. Additional faculty will be added if demand necessitates it.

***Please come prepared with materials to play** in the lessons and ensembles to read.

***Housing and meals** will be at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University (ERAU). All dorm rooms are air-conditioned and carpeted with private bathrooms and include a microwave and refrigerator; linens and pillow will be provided. ERAU is a 15+ minute walk from the DBC music buildings; car-pools will run between the two campuses for those who would rather not walk. If you plan to drive or rent a car in Daytona please note it on the application for parking purposes.

***Air transportation** to Daytona Beach International Airport (DAB) is available on Delta, Continental and AirTran. The airport is virtually next door to ERAU and a taxi to the dorms would be very inexpensive. ERAU and DBC are just off **I-95** at the International Speedway exit (east bound) if you choose to **drive**.

***Daytona Beach** sits on the Atlantic Ocean in north-central Florida. It has a sub-tropical climate. DBC and ERAU are on a major thoroughfare that boasts the Volusia Mall, a vast array of restaurants, the Daytona Beach International Airport, Halifax Hospital and the Daytona International Speedway. The Atlantic Ocean is approximately 5 miles from either school and serviced by public transportation.

***Course fees:** \$800.00 (**all fees:** Mon. afternoon, July 28-Sun. morning, August 3)
\$500.00 (course only fee – no dorm housing or meal plan)
\$650.00 (course fee and meal ticket – no dorm housing)

A non-refundable deposit of \$250 is required at the time of application
